Next4Vets curriculum, which includes classroom time and individual coaching, helps participants accelerate and advance their careers by successfully leveraging their military experience within a corporate setting. The program focuses on strategies beyond technical skills and leadership competencies to use the power of reputation and perception within the context of a company's culture.

Program Framework

- Class size limited to 16 participants
- Led by two instructors with military and corporate experience
- Four half-day sessions over a four-month period
- Customized assessments and two hours of individual coaching

Ideal Program Candidates

- Female veterans from all U.S. Military branches, including Reserves
- Currently employed
- Officer or enlisted
- No restriction on the number of years of separation from military service
